WATER, WATER EVERYWHERE!

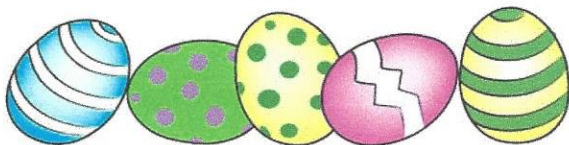
Remember that by reducing water usage during heavy rains YOU can reduce the strain on our sewer system.
